In order to strengthen our commitment to safety, Plumbers Local Union #1 and the Association of Contracting Plumbers of the City of New York, Inc., have agreed that **no existing Helper will advance in term/grade (wages and fringe benefits) unless he/she successfully completes an OSHA 10 course. All new Helpers must successfully complete the OSHA 10 course within 90 days of hiring.** Both requirements become effective January 1, 2009.
